Dear Parent,

You, as a parent of a Triton Elementary School kindergarten student are blessed with a wonderful opportunity to provide your child “HOPE” for his/her future. All of us, as parents, want our children to have a rewarding and successful future. First Source Bank has partnered with Triton Schools to help us launch PROMISE INDIANA this year. If you open a 529 Savings account for your child in October at your parent/teacher conference, First Source Bank will deposit \$25 in that account for your child’s future educational needs. A 529 Savings Plan gives you a tax credit (we all can use that) and tells your child that you believe in their ability to learn and become whatever they want to be when they grow up. Studies show that students who have saved \$1-\$499 dollars by the time they graduate from high school are 3 times more likely to continue their education after high school and four times more likely to finish that training.
