Measles

There have been four identified measles cases in Indiana in the past week. The involved counties are Boone and Hamilton.

At this time, no exposures have occurred in the school setting.

A rash illness in a patient with high fever should prompt immediate consideration of measles, especially in unvaccinated individuals or individuals with risk factors. Those risk factors will include recent overseas travel and unknown or incomplete vaccination status.

Summer Little League Baseball and Softball Registration.

Sign-up registration forms are in the Triton Elementary office for tee-ball, minor league, major league and girls' softball. These leagues are for boys and girls in the Triton school district and surrounding areas. Tee-ball is for boys and girls ages 4, 5, and 6. The minor league is for boy's ages 7, 8, and 9. Major league is for boy's ages 10, 11, and 12. Girl's minor softball is for girls age 7, 8, 9 and major softball is for girls ages 10, 11, 13. These ages are based on the age that occurs on December 30, 2011. Registration fee is \$35.00 per child. For 2 children of the same family the fee will be \$65.00. For a family that has 3 or more children the fee will be \$95.00. All registration forms and fees must be turned into the Triton Elementary office by Friday, February 24, 2012.
