Digital Learning Day

Dear Families,

Triton Elementary will be “making up” a snow day for the first time ever using a Digital Learning Day. Much research and thought has gone into the planning, and we are anxious to see how well it is executed. As you know, we held a Practice DLD November 19. Approximately 80% of students in grades K-6 participated fully and completed assignments. Scheduling a Digital Learning Day following a school cancellation (instead of the same day) has its advantages. It allows us to ensure students have the appropriate devices and materials with them to complete the work, and we can offer Wi-fi access to those who do not have it which may not be feasible during inclement weather. In addition, students will have a five-day window to complete assignments and may login at any time during the window. Teachers will have ample time to prepare lessons that they know will be completed independently at home. Staff will be available via email, phone, or chat to help students and respond to queries from parents as well. We know that “first tries” often lead to future adjustments, so we appreciate your grace and understanding as we try this together. Please look for more details which will be sent home next week!
