As a school, we are eager for the day when we can return to normal operating procedures especially regarding public events and larger gatherings. In the meantime we will do our best to keep students and staff **healthy** and **in school**. That includes frequent hand washing and sanitizing, sending home students who are ill, identifying and quarantining close contacts to COVID-positive individuals, and communicating regularly with our county health departments.
