Triton is pleased to offer nutritious breakfasts and lunches daily. Menus for the week are available on back of Friday Newsnotes. (Please be advised that due to limited availability, menus could change without advance notice.) Costs are as follows:

Student Breakfast	\$1.20
Student Lunch	\$2.20
Adult Lunch	\$4.60

Children with a negative lunch balance that exceeds \$5.00 will be served an alternate meal meeting regulations defined by the National School Lunch and Breakfast programs and charged \$1. A child will not be allowed to go without lunch. If a child does not bring a packed lunch, he/she will be served a school lunch which will be charged to his/her account.

We advise families to complete forms for textbook/meals assistance as soon as possible. New forms must be completed each year and are available during registration in the elementary office.

## Change in Breakfast Routine

Breakfast is served in the **cafeteria** 7:45-8:15. Walkers and those dropped off by car may enter as they arrive from Doors 3 and 6. Students riding the bus will be dismissed at 7:55 to get breakfast and should report directly to the cafeteria. All students should be finished with breakfast and in classrooms by 8:20. Please make your children aware of this change if they plan to eat breakfast.
