From the Principal

Dear Families,

When I think about the last grading period of 2020, I am so grateful that this year will be different. While COVID precautions are still in place to keep everyone safe and physically in school, things are starting to feel less stressful and teaching and learning continue. A major difference from last spring is the return of state assessments which were canceled last year due to school closures. In a couple of weeks, students in grades 3,4,5,6 will take ILEARN which measures mastery of grade level standards in Math, Language Arts, Science (4,6) and Social Studies (5). The assessment will be divided into several shorter sessions with testing being completed each day before lunch. Students do their best work when they test with their class, so please help your child by making sure they are on time each day and schedule appointments after school or in the afternoon if necessary. A complete schedule will be provided next week.
