Third graders across Indiana participate in IREAD-3 each spring to evaluate reading proficiency. This assessment measures a child's ability to read and comprehend third grade level text in preparation for fourth grade. Triton's overall result is also an indicator of the strength of our reading program in grades K-3. This past year, more than 80,000 Indiana students took IREAD-3, and 81.9% passed. **Triton's overall passing rate was 91%.** While there is always room for improvement, we are very pleased with the efforts of our teachers, students, and support staff. This may be one test at one point in time, but we are working everyday all year long to help build proficient readers!
