COVID Update

As a school, we are eager for the day when we can return to normal operating procedures especially regarding public events and larger gatherings. In the meantime we will do our best to keep students and staff **healthy** and **in school**. That includes frequent hand washing and sanitizing, sending home students who are ill, identifying and quarantining close contacts to COVID-positive individuals, and communicating regularly with our county health departments. Since the vast majority of the positive cases are still adults, we continue to limit visitors to our building and opportunities for large gatherings such as music programs, and in-school assemblies where distancing or outdoor options are not possible. We are aware that many people are attending social gatherings outside of school, but our responsibility is for our students and families while at school or school-sponsored functions.
