## Morning Drop-OFF!

Hello Families-Please help ensure the safety of students by following the guidelines below when you drop off students on Thayer street behind the elementary.

1. **Please do not drop off BEFORE 7:45 am.** There is no adult supervision until 7:45. At 8:10 Supervisors leave the drop off area and the doors lock every morning.
2. Pull forward as far as possible up to the Stop Sign or behind the car in front of you.
3. Allow students to exit the vehicle only on the doors next to the sidewalk.
4. Do not park on Thayer and walk students to the door. Keep traffic moving.
5. If you want to walk students to the door, park next to the playground.
6. Be aware of your surroundings and be patient and courteous of others.
