### Lice Notification

We have detected cases of head lice within our school community. Please check your child's hair as soon as possible.

**Check the scalp**, especially behind ears and at the nape of the neck,

**Look for tiny, crawling insects** or small white nits (eggs) cemented to hair shafts.

**Treat** if lice or nits are found, use a specialized lice treatment shampoo immediately.

**Comb**-use a fine-toothed nit comb to remove all remaining eggs after treatment.

**Clean**-Wash bedding, towels, and recently worn clothing in hot water. High heat for 20 minutes.
