A child will not be allowed to go without lunch. If a child does not bring a packed lunch, he/she will be served a school lunch which will be charged to his/her account.

We advise families to complete forms for meal assistance as soon as possible.

Lice Notification

We have detected cases of head lice within our school community. Please check your child's hair as soon as possible.

Check the scalp, especially behind ears and at the nape of the neck.

Look for tiny, crawling insects or small white nits (eggs) cemented to hair shafts.

Treat-if lice or nits are found, use a specialized lice treatment shampoo immediately.

Comb-use a fine-toothed nit comb to remove all remaining eggs after treatment.

Clean-Wash bedding, towels, and recently worn clothing in hot water. High heat for 20 minutes.
