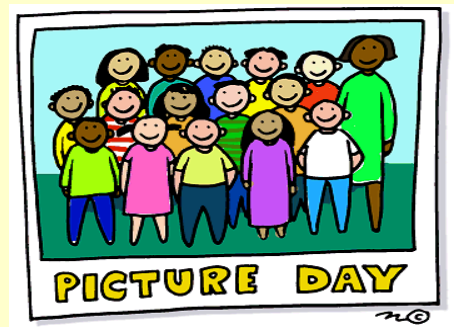

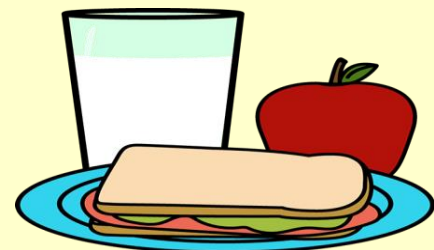
Meal Information
